

Annual Scholarship Report

The Creston Alumni Association continues to encourage, motivate and inspire our current students and past graduates to accomplish their higher education dreams. Your donations enabled us to award in June of 2022, eight scholarships totaling \$22,000, bringing the grand total of scholarships awarded in 27 years to \$327,985! Four scholarships were awarded to graduating seniors and four to former recipients.

Because of the recently formed Wilbur Creston High School Co-op, it is noted that the scholarships are designated for students registered with the Creston School District only. Any past graduate of Creston High School may apply for an alumni scholarship as well. To be eligible, the student must plan to attend or be enrolled in a college, university or accredited vocational school. Applicants are required to have a minimum of a 2.5 cumulative high school grade point average, or a 2.00 cumulative college grade point average, complete an application stating all activities, (school and extracurricular), awards and honors received, community service and employment experience. Also included must be two letters of reference, and a letter stating why they should be considered, including financial need, grades, importance of college and future plans. Five members of the scholarship committee make the decisions based on the criteria submitted in the application. The Silent Auction at last year's reunion brought in \$410 thanks to the generous donations received. The items were all donated by alumni to help raise more money for scholarships.


